President's Corner. Since the last 21MC was published on June 23, 2021, we have firmed up many more details for the reunion for September 9th through the 12th, 2021 in Bremerton, WA. NOTES CONCERNING USS TURNER JOY REUNION GROUP 2021 REUNION IN BREMERTON, WA

- 1. Please bring a Face Mask for each person, just in case there is a change in the COVID-19 situation.
- Upon check In at the Hampton Inn and the Fairfield Inn, be sure to state clearly you are
 with the <u>USS TURNER JOY REUNION GROUP</u>. Room rate for the reunion is \$114.00 per
 night (despite hotel confusions) and parking is paid by the <u>USS TURNER JOY REUNION</u>
 GROUP!
- 3. The USS Stonewall Jackson (SSBN-634) is having a reunion at the Hampton Inns and Suites on the same dates as our reunion! We have asked the Hampton Inn if all their rooms are NOT filled if they would reserve those unused rooms for the TJRG, if necessary!
- 4. Upon check In at the Hampton Inn and the Fairfield Inn, you will receive a tote bag with a small containers of hand sanitizer, facemasks, two bottles of purified drinking water and two USS Turner Joy patches (if they arrive on time) for You and your Wife/SO/Guest/Family!
- 5. Our Hospitality Suite is room 330 at the Hampton Inn.
- 6. For the Business Meeting, we encourage all TJRG Members to attend. Due to room occupancy restrictions and current COVID-19 restrictions still in effect, Wives/SO/other Guests will not be able to attend. Please have your special person in life give you any agenda items to be brought up at the business meeting.

We are still negotiating the Bus Tour Contract, depending on those who select the tour and will adjust the Revenues and Expenses as necessary after the contract has been agreed upon and signed by all parties! We hope by the 2nd 21MC Newsletter, that we intend to put out on or about 21 August, 2021, we will have all the necessary finalized information. Per Person cost for the bus tour will stay at \$75 per passenger.
